Summer Staff Support Raising

Wildwood Hills Ranch provides an incredible life-changing experience! Within this opportunity we also recognize the investment and sacrifice involved in being on summer staff. Being a part of this ministry is a blessing and participating in the support raising process allows you to invite others to partner with you in this ministry!

Overview

Every summer staff has the opportunity to raise financial support in addition to their summer stipend, housing, and meals.

To be eligible for this opportunity, the summer staff member must be committed to all 7 sessions of programming, plus the staff training weeks required for their position.

- Maximum amount to raise: \$2,200
- Deadline: raised funds must be donated by July 31st
- Surplus donations: all excess donations will be allocated to the summer staff scholarship fund to assist future ministry impact
- All donations are tax deductible

Action Steps

- 1. Opt-in to the support raising process and have your name added to the donation option list on our website.
- 2. Make personal asks to your contact list and community: we encourage letters, phone calls, social media, and face to face conversations.
- 3. Track your progress in coordination with Wildwood Hills Ranch Finance Director.
- 4. Send regular updates and stories to your support team.
- 5. Send personalized thank yous to each individual donor on your support team.
- 6. Send an end of summer overview and thank you to your support team.

Support Amounts Paid to Summer Staff:

- 95% of donated money will be received by the summer staff member. 5% of each donation, plus any donations in excess of an individual's maximum, will be used to cover expenses associated with the Summer Staff Scholarship Program or used for future funds. This means that each summer staff participating will be able to take home a maximum of \$2,100.
- You will receive donated money through checks once a month or in a total amount at the end of the summer. You will be able to discuss timing with our Finance Director during staff training.

Donation Tax Receipts:

- Donors will receive a tax-deduction receipt at the end of the year directly from Wildwood
- Tax ID Number is: 42-1517411

Surplus Amount Raised:

• If you raise over the \$2,200.00 maximum, the money will continue to go towards the community you will be working with. Because the money is donated with the understanding that it will be used in the summer staff scholarship fund, we cannot return it. Please monitor your balance often so you know when you are approaching your goal. On the other hand, you will quickly fall in love with the community you serve in and see the value of where this money is being used. If you have a great support system that is able to provide above and beyond, it will be a huge blessing.

Making the Ask

Face to Face Conversations or Phone Calls:

- Set up face to face conversations with those in your contact list.
- Share the passion and heart behind your decision to serve this summer. How your personal investment in Wildwood this summer will make a Kingdom impact. Share about what Wildwood's mission is.
- Make the ask: clearly outline your goals for the summer both personally and financially. Ask them to prayerfully consider supporting you.
- Give them the information on how they could donate: check and online.
- Thank them for their time!

Letters:

- Use the template letter in this packet as a starting point. Edit it to add in your own personal story.
- Send this letter to as many people as you can in your contact list. Don't hesitate to reach out!
- Clearly outline ways for them to support you financially: check or online.
- Follow up: feel free to give them a call two weeks after you have sent your letter.

Social Media:

- Create a page for your summer experience and invite friends to join it. This can be a platform that you post updates, stories, and more throughout your summer experience.
- Make specific posts about how others can join you in making a Kingdom impact: pray and give.
- Direct your contacts to the donation page on the Wildwood Hills Ranch website: www.wildwoodhillsranch.org/donate
- Utilize the Wildwood Hills Ranch social media pages and website for ideas on pictures or things to share to communicate the mission of Wildwood and your summer experience.

People Might Ask You

Why are you needing to raise support?

Wildwood Hills Ranch is a nonprofit youth development organization that provides 100% scholarship to the students who participate in programming. In addition, the organization runs on primarily individual donors to cover all operational expenses, staffing, and programming. Wildwood Hills Ranch provides a weekly stipend to each summer staff member that covers basic needs. The money I raise in addition to this stipend allows me to save for college classes, monthly bills, and more. The money I raise provides me with comparable income to a for-profit job.

What happens if you don't raise enough support or raise over the maximum amount?

The maximum amount I am striving to raise is \$2,200. If I do not raise this full amount I will not be able to save for future expenses, education costs, etc. Every part of this amount is helpful to me for the present and the future! If I raise more than the maximum amount, the surplus dollars will be added to the Summer Scholarship Fund for future summer staff members to participate in the mission of Wildwood Hills Ranch.

Can people continue to donate through the summer?

Yes! If donors wish to give during the summer they are more than welcome to. All donations need to be submitted before July 31st.

How can a donor stay up-to-date on what you and Wildwood Hills Ranch are doing?

You can send updates via email, social media, letters, etc. Donors are also welcome to join the Wildwood Hills Ranch newsletter and follow us on social media.

How to Make It Work

Be Prayerful

Pray daily for God to lead the way and make your ministry possible this summer. Ask Him to break down the walls that are built up against your mission. Remember that the summer is not about you or Wildwood; it is about Christ and the impact He wants to make in Iowa's most vulnerable youth.

Be Proactive

God will do His part, now you have to do your part. Make a list of contacts you can mail out letters to. Make a list of those whom you think will donate online. Check off the names on the list. Make sure to follow through. Use both the letter method and the online method. Invest in a method beyond these two options. People are busy and often forgetful, so do not be afraid to follow up and ask if they've had any time to consider supporting you.

Be Prepared

Be confident and know what you're talking about. Familiarize yourself with Wildwood Hills Ranch's mission and know the community well. Make sure you are well equipped to answer questions that may come up. Be sure to read through the "People Might Ask" section for all the answers you will need.

Be Present

Put aside time to work on your support raising efforts. Set aside a morning or afternoon for making phone calls. If you make yourself present and available for a day or two, you will be grateful in the end. The sooner you get your support raised, the more relieved you will be.

Be Passionate

You are here because God has called you to serve. That in and of itself is truly an exciting thing. I hope you are as excited as we are about the calling God has placed on you this summer. Friends and family will sense your passion and confidence in this call and will be eager to join you in your mission this summer.

Be Personal

If someone chooses to support you, show him or her your thanks! Send them a personal thank you card and ask them if they want to stay updated with Wildwood Hills Ranch. If they do, we can add them to our monthly email newsletter. It would also be a good idea to fill them in at the end of the summer with a letter about what you did and how they made it possible.
